Riley, who assumed the position in July, brings many years of varied experience to the organization. He was most recently Chief Program Officer for Eisenhower Fellowships (EF), an international organization based in Philadelphia that works to connect impactful leaders from all sectors with international counterparts.

"Jason's enthusiasm for the mission and dedication to community service make him a great fit for the organization. A Philadelphia native, Riley began his involvement in service to the community while in high school as vice president of the Community Service Corps for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. Riley earned his undergraduate degree from Saint Joseph's University, where he received the university's first full scholarship for community service.

He went on to direct the newly created Office of Community Service at Temple University, increasing student involvement in the neighboring communities by more than 200%, while creating a culture of engagement among the student body. After leaving the university, he developed a residential construction business, then joined Eisenhower Fellowships, during which time he obtained his Master of Public Administration degree at the Fels Institute of Government, University of Pennsylvania.

Riley's experience also includes a year in Puerto Rico working to develop a youth organization and study at Universidad Centroamericana in El Salvador, where he worked at a community cooperative that provided dental services and vocational training.
